BYLAWS & SOVEREIGNTY ARTICLES

ARTICLE X+2 – NON-DISCLOSURE AND NON-COMPETE

Confidential Information includes treaty negotiations, legal strategies, sacred locations, and membership data.

Members shall not disclose or use confidential information without authorization.

ARTICLE X+3 – TREATY RIGHTS AND SOVEREIGNTY

Recognition of Aboriginal Title, Treaty supremacy, and Indigenous rights under international law.

ARTICLE I – NAME AND PURPOSE

This Association is established to protect Indigenous sovereignty, treaty rights, and cultural heritage.

ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP

Membership includes Indigenous descendants committed to sovereignty and treaty protection.

ARTICLE III – GOVERNANCE

Council authority over treaty enforcement and land rights.

ARTICLE IV – LAND PROTECTION

Affirms rights under the Treaty of 1866 and prior occupancy.

ARTICLE V – INDEMNIFICATION

Protection of members acting in good faith.

ARTICLE VI – HOLD HARMLESS

Members protected from liability during lawful activities.

ARTICLE VII – CONFIDENTIALITY

Strict protection of sensitive information.

ARTICLE VIII – NON-COMPETE

Prevents misuse of collective efforts.

ARTICLE IX – MEETINGS

Governance procedures and quorum rules.

ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS

Protects treaty rights from alteration.

ARTICLE XI – DISSOLUTION

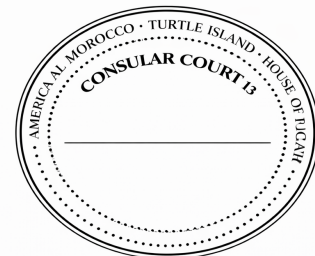
Assets remain within Indigenous entities.

ARTICLE XII – SEVERABILITY

Ensures continued enforcement of valid provisions.
